2016, by the former Lord Chief Justice, the former Senior President of
Tribunals and the then Lord Chancellor

The (current) key targets of the Family Reform Programme are:

- Development and introduction of 'new' technology for the family court aimed at making the system simpler and more efficient for everyone;
- Improved court estate;
- Consultation regarding enhanced 'authorised officer' (legal adviser) functions to lighten the burden on judges

- Divorce online
- Family Public Law and Adoption
- Financial remedy consent orders
- Private Law?? Sept 2020-March 2022

#### Electronic working

- Paperless
- Centralised
- 'Common Capabilities' technology;

#### Video hearings

- 'Fully Video Hearings' project
- Different from CVP
- Pilot March 2019-March 2020
- 2<sup>nd</sup> evaluation report from LSE July 2020 made 17 recommendations
- Original timescales 2018-ongoing
